

HOW TO REGISTER WITH US

To join the surgery, you usually have to live within our practice boundary. You can find out if you are by visiting our website, or scan the QR code here:



If you're eligible, you can complete the online patient registration form. Alternatively, visit one of our surgeries and our reception team will be happy to help.

TRIAGE & APPOINTMENT BOOKING

You can contact us using our online forms (available via the QR code below or the NHS App) to submit medical requests, administrative queries and repeat prescription requests. Online contact is available Monday to Friday, 8:00am to 6:30pm, excluding bank holidays. You may also contact the surgery by telephone or visit us during these hours.

If you prefer not to speak at the desk, you may complete a privacy slip and our team will pass your request to the on-call doctor on your behalf. All medical requests are then reviewed by a doctor, who will either respond directly or arrange for the most appropriate clinician to help you. This may be a GP, nurse, pharmacist, paramedic, advanced nurse practitioner or first-contact physiotherapist. You may be directed to another suitable service if this is the best option for your care. Our website can also be used to request test results, update contact details or submit administrative queries, though responses are provided during opening hours only. Please note that same-day appointments are reserved for urgent clinical problems.

REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

The quickest way to request a repeat prescription is via the NHS App. We are unable to accept requests by phone and so if you're unable to use the app, requests can be made via our website, in person, or by handing in the tear-off slip at reception. Please allow 3 working days for processing.

To reduce medicine waste and ensure safe prescribing, prescriptions cannot be issued early.

If you run out of medication urgently, you can contact NHS 111 online or call 111 for an emergency prescription service. Some pharmacies may also be able to supply medicines in an emergency, though some might incur a fee.

TEST RESULTS

You can view your test results via the NHS App. Alternatively you can submit an administrative request through our website, or contact reception. For confidentiality reasons, results can only be released to the patient they relate to, unless prior permission has been given or the patient is unable to understand the results. Photo ID may be required.

COMPLAINTS & FEEDBACK

Feedback helps us to learn and to improve services. If you wish to share your views and experiences, please speak to a member of staff. If you wish to make a formal complaint, we advise this is done as soon as possible after the event.
